Q: WHAT TIME DOES THE WALK START?

8:00 a.m. | Site opens

9:45 a.m. | Opening Ceremony begins

10:00 a.m. | Walk begins

10:00 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. | Festival site remains open for participants to visit sponsor booths, listen to music and other activities

Q: HOW WILL I RECEIVE MY T-SHIRT?

We are now mailing all shirts for \$100+ fundraisers, survivors and those living with metastatic breast cancer. **In order to receive your shirt in time for Walk day*, you must have registered and/or fundraised \$100+ by Sunday, September 14, 2025.** Survivors and those living with metastatic breast cancer who register, and participants who raise \$100, after Sunday, September 14, 2025 will receive your shirt(s) by mail after the event. The final cut-off date for participants to raise \$100 and receive a shirt is Sunday, November 9, 2025.

*Shirts are being mailed via USPS. As with any shipping provider, delays may occur.

Please note: there will be no t-shirts available for pick up either pre-event or on event day. Thank you for your commitment to Susan G. Komen and our efforts to simplify our t-shirt process.

HOW LONG WILL THE WALK BE?

The Walk will be close to 5k (3 miles) with a 1 mile fun walk marker for those who wish to walk a shorter distance.

Q: IS THERE PARKING AND PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION?:

There are several paid lots and garages available on-site. National Harbor is also accessible via Metro and complimentary shuttle busses will be provided. Further details are forthcoming.

Parking: National Harbor offers a variety of convenient paid parking options including covered garages, surface lots and metered street parking. Daily Parking Rate for all National Harbor Parking Lots & Garages:

- **0 to 1.5 Hours — \$5**
- **1.5 to 3 Hours — \$15**
- **3 to 4.5 Hours — \$20**

St. George Boulevard & Waterman Passage National Harbor, MD 20745
Multi-level covered garage open 24-hours, 7 days a week including holidays.

METRO: The closest METRO stop to National Harbor is Southern Avenue on the Green Line. There will be shuttle buses there to take participants from the Southern Avenue stop only, to National Harbor. There will be a continuous loop of shuttle buses between the hours of 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. After exiting the METRO stop, shuttle buses will be situated past the Park-n-Ride and stationed where other buses are located. There will be signage and volunteers to direct you as to where to wait for the next shuttle bus to take you to National Harbor, as well as at National Harbor for return trips to the Metro and/or Park-n-Ride. You may also park at the nearby Park-n-Ride for free and walk over to the shuttle buses at the METRO stop, if you choose. Link to map

Q: WHY WAS THE DATE CHANGED?

For several years we have applied for a permit for the Walk to be held in October to coincide with National Breast Cancer Awareness Month. Based on availability, we will not be granted a permit in the near future to have the Walk in October anywhere in DC.

Having the Walk in October lengthens the timeline for participant recruitment and fundraising, which will undoubtedly result in even more funds being raised for our mission.

Q: WHY WAS THE LOCATION CHANGED?

Location was changed to coincide with the date change, which meant we had to go outside of DC to find an appropriate venue. Sharepointe at National Harbor has held several successful charitable races/walks, with a beautiful walking trail that is adjacent to the Potomac River. There is also plentiful space for the stage, sponsor booths and other fun and engaging activities.
