IN-PERSON RACE DETAILS

GETTING TO THE RACE

The Komen Houston Race for the Cure® route is located adjacent to the beautiful Buffalo Bayou on Allen Parkway. Allow ample time for possible traffic delays and parking entrance lines in the area due to the high volume of vehicles headed into downtown. Please note that Allen Parkway will be closed early Saturday morning.

COMPETITIVE/ NON-COMPETITVE RUNNERS

The Start Line is located on the Southbound lanes of Allen Parkway. The 5K Competitive timed runners will receive a blue bib number along with a timing chip. The 5k Non-Competitive runners will receive a green bib. Timed runners are encouraged to line up as early as possible in the designated area.

FAMILY/KIDS WALK

Participants interested in the Family Walk will begin at the Start Line and turn at Taft Street to head to Finish Line. Please follow the signs to line up in the designated area no later than 8:10am.

5K WALK

The Start Line is on Allen Parkway east of Taft Street, between the over pass of I-45 and the pedestrian bridge. Please follow the signs to line up in the designated area no later than 8:15 am.

Medical Stations are set up on Allen Parkway near the Finish Line. Gillette and Montrose.


