GETTING TO THE RACE

The Houston Race for the Cure route is located adjacent to the beautiful Buffalo Bayou on Allen Parkway. Allow ample time for possible traffic delays and parking entrance lines in the area due to the high volume of vehicles headed downtown. Please note that Allen Parkway will be closed early Saturday morning.

6:15am – Site and on-site registration opens

7:00am – Survivors and those living with MBC meet at Hope Village for IHOP breakfast

7:30 am – Opening Ceremonies with Memorial Birds Release

8:00am – Competitive (timed) 5K Begins Followed by: Non-Competitive 5K Family Walk/Kids K

9:30am – Runners Award Ceremony Survivor Celebration at Sam Houston Park

COMPETITIVE/ NON-COMPETITIVE RUNNERS

The Start Line is located on the Southbound lanes of Allen Parkway. The 5K Competitive timed runners will receive a white bib number along with a timing chip. Timed runners are encouraged to line up as early as possible in the designated area. Runners at the back of the line may experience congestion.

FAMILY/KIDS 1K WALK

Participants interested in the Family Walk will begin at the Start Line and turn at Taft Street to head to Finish Line. Please follow the signs to line up in the designated area no later than 8:10am. <u>Children</u> will receive a non-competitive race medal generously sponsored by **NOV**.

RUNNER AWARDS

Awards will be given for Competitive 5K runners: Top 3 Overall Male/Female 5K Finishers, Top 3 Male/Female in each 5K Age Group

Results are based on chip time.

All timed participants will receive an individual results page complete with your results, pace breakdown, a finisher certificate & a 20 second video of you crossing the start & finish line!
